  - iii. Discussion concerning the North Lake Boat Ramp:
    - Review of the rebuilding of the South Lake Boat Ramp by Scotts's Customizing & restorations. Inc.
      - a. Approval needed: Saint Johns Water Management District, Army Corp of Engineers, Florida EPA.
    - N. Lake grade is steeper than S. Lake.
    - N. Lake ramp continues to wash out at the end of the ramp.
    - LAMSBD discussing the dropping the N. Lake level 3 12 inches to facilitate repairs to the dam. Possible decision by the LAMSBD Board in February Meeting.
    - LALLOA will need to issue a Low Water Level Lake Advisory to include a "No Wake" warning for all near shoreline and inlets. Bulkheads are at risk for severe erosion and possible failure due to wave action during times of lower water levels.
