- New Business (Wantage)
 - Lake Watch reporting & Algae in Lake Asbury -
 - UF reported the following:
 - Walt Giebeig spoke with Brian Davis with FDEP today. He said he has good news and bad news.
 - Looking at the pictures I sent him he said that they do not have any health concerns with the algae bloom that's in the north lake. It is called Filamentous Algae and is not harmful to humans. I read up on it a little it looks like the algae is growing in response to nutrients that have washed into the lake, so excessive growth of algae may indicate that there are other pollutants that also have washed into the water.

Now for the bad news. They can't do anything about it bc we are a private lake and it is the HOA's responsibility to take care of it. He recommended us contacting a consulting firm like.....Lake doc's or Aquadic Inc. to treat the lake for Algae.

Looking at the recent results of the lake samples both lakes are significantly higher in Phosphorous, Nitrogen and Chlorophyll(see examples below. I compared around the same time of year but back in 2007 when the last samples were takin. The avg are out to the side(huge difference)). This goes hand in hand to why the Algae bloom may be exploding. Why is there such an increase and where is coming from? I would not think that the community is using that much more fertilizer on their yards then what they were using 14yrs ago. Is it because of all of the construction and earth moving that is going on around us that is releasing it and then it is getting washed into the lake (I don't want to assume)?

- The spare lock was put on the LA Ramp gate in a daisy chain fashion as that lock no longer works 100%. A new lock is needed if the old one can't be repaired.
 Bentley will work to on a solution to removing the old lock as it is welded to the chain and not easily removed.
