• Lake Watch, Weed Control & Storm Water (Wantage & Giebieg & Clemons)

- Status of Permit from FWC Has been received and turned over to the LAMSBD
- Lake Watch Report Clemons and Giebieg Mike reported the quality and clarity of the lake seems better this past quarter. However they are still waiting to gather at least a year's worth of reports to create an adequate report.
- Weeds & Algae This project has been adopted by the LAMSBD. There are three methods to eliminate weeds: Chemical, Manual and Adding Fish. Each has their pros and cons. Although Water hyacinths and lettuce are only two of our problems, they can both be easily removed using manual means. A neighborhood workday project was discussed and Larry Pence was identified as lead on the project. The idea is to encourage the lakefront property owners to clean up their waterfront within FWC guidelines, as a first step.
- Storm Water Mark Wantage reports that he has identified multiple areas around lake needing attention by Clay County. He has created a document for them identifying the location, the concern, what he observed, items reported and the research on each location. He is pending a response from the county.

 Our entire community was invited. The So Lake Ramp area was closed in light of the danger of the explosives. The dam offered a great viewing. The show was enormously enjoyed by the viewers.

- LAMSBD Chair Alton Davis invited the attendees to come to the next LAMSBD meeting at 6:30 on Oct 3rd where the Hanson Engineering team will be reporting the status of Phase 1 of their project. On Aug 24th, Hanson and SJRWMD were on-site and reviewed the dams and other areas.
