• Chains at Ramps are loose and can be removed. Ensure chains are affixed to the gates

· Floating Docks

 Addresses are needed for the 2 reported docks anchored beyond the 15foot line; one is on Candler Ct – Manly will accompany Wantage to identify the docks. (Wantage needs to repair his water vessel first)

- Letter needs to be created to send to the 2 households
- Removal of Deed Restriction Warning at entrances has been completed

 Discuss any additional needed changes to Charter before filing amended document with the county. Current amendment includes adding word voluntary to Article I Section 6b

Board is reviewing gaps and has sent questions to LALLOA's attorney. Once response has been finalized the Charter will be updated.

• Plan Review Committee:

• Copy of new PRA form was distributed in Annual Meeting notice and is available on website

• Is there an issue with 201 Arthur Moore – This is a county issue. The property owner would need to use the form on the County's site to make a complaint.

• Public Comment (Barrett)

- Barrett made a motion that LALLOA purchase a Laptop PC to be used by LALLOA secretary considering not everyone has a PC and this would be for the exclusive use of LALLOA. Bunn seconded the motion. Approved by all
- Alton Davis (Chair of LAMSBD) reported that Tompson Contracting Services was
 recently hired to repair damaged South Lake dam. SJRWMD is following
 progress. A six-week repair is anticipated and may require a short term lane
 closure. No permits were needed. The work starts on Wed July 21. The erosion
 issue spotted on the south face of the dam will also be repaired.
- Who is addressing the stormwater issue LAMSBD or LALLOA? Wantage responded
- Issues with Henley & Sandridge still in progress
- Issues with Henley & Cokesbury collapsed vault has been repaired
- New retention ponds across Henley drain into ?? (missed that)
- Lake Asbury Watershed Study started in late 2022 and to be completed in early 2024.
- County is the agent and responsible for storm water and its effects.
- Washout @ Arthur Moore was from an old farmpipe that collapsed due to bad install and age. 50 yards of fill was added to the site via the repair.
- On county's schedule to be inspected are other similar sites and the sediment boxes scattered throughout LA
- All damages must be reported to the county. Anyone can contact the county.
- Some attendees requested that the meetings be recorded for later viewing.
 Board is concerned with the integrity/security of the recorded file as it would need to be protected from tampering. Affordability is a concern
- Questioning if Lake Doctors is working on the lake at Fells Ct. Board had no information on that claim.

• Can the board restrict the size of the boat or engine on the boat? LALLOA has not been able to do that task. Possibly LAMSBD?
